
Apply eakin Wound Pouch™ in 3 simple steps

STEP 1: POUCH PREPARATION


Use plastic template provided and position over fistula or wound.

The words EAKIN WOUND POUCH should be in reverse.




TRACE outline of fine

outline of fistula or wound using a felt tip permanent marker. Ensure to stay within the purple grid.




3 CUT out along the outline you have created.



FLIP the template over. The words EAKIN WOUND POUCH on the template should now read correctly and line up with the text on the white release paper underneath.

Trace the wound shape and cut out the eakin Cohesive® from the starter hole to the correct shape.







STEP 2: SKIN PREPARATION

Clean and dry the surrounding skin.
Avoid the use of emollient based cleansers.




Prepare your workspace and to measure your wound accurately: length and width

To prevent leakage it is essential to create an even pouching surface. Fill in scars, creases and crevices with eakin Cohesive® seals, eakin Cohesive® skin barriers and/or eakin Cohesive® paste.




STEP 3: POUCH APPLICATION

Remove the paper backing and carefully apply the eakin Wound Pouch™ to clean, dry skin.



Apply firm but gentle pressure to the skin barrier for at least 30 seconds to ensure that the adhesive adheres to the skin surface.
